



Confirmation Requirements

The following is required of students preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation:

Two-year program, beginning in 7th grade and completion in 8th grade

- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, and Eucharist
- Regular attendance at weekend Mass
- Parent/Student Meeting
- Attendance at regular Faith Formation classes, which includes lessons on the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Completion of homework for any absence
- Complete community service as described below

These additional requirements are for eighth grade only:

- Attend Confirmation Retreat
- Complete & turn in required documents
- Confirmation Practice
- Sacrament of Confirmation

Community Service for 7th & 8th Grade

In order to prepare yourself to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, it is important that you spend time going out into the world and being Christ to others. There are many ways you can do that, and to help you start, below are four categories that introduce you to new and to familiar ways to serve others, including your family.

Students need to complete one project for each category: Family, Parish, Community, and Spiritual. How to obtain the required service will be covered in the parent/student meeting.
